Thereby this course will embrace knowledge about social policy, NGOs in Taiwan, general social work in Taiwan, and social workers' identity and tasks. Furthermore, this course will provide a trans-disciplinary practical experience of social work in Taiwan. The focus is on the social system for elderly people and practical experience with youth in Taiwan. The lecturer's personal working experience in Taiwan Fund for Children and Families Taipei office with young adults in Taiwan will give the knowledge of social work methods in theory and practice. It will compare the difference between Taiwan and Germany's case management and casework in the field of adult education and elderly people's care and social welfare system.</p> <p>Students have developed an understanding of the role and tasks of social work regarding intercultural sensitization as well as regarding one's understanding of the profession in the context of a continuously increasing intercultural society.</p>
